DIY TEACHER/STUDENT CAMERA STAND FOR CRAFTING

What you need:

- A smartphone
- Two full 2-liter pop/Martinellis bottles or other tall bottles with flat tops
- 1 yard stick
- Duct tape
- Two heavy rubber bands that fit snugly around your smartphone



If you place the phone on top of the yard stick with the camera lens to the side, you can see the control screen.

For a long class it is a good idea to have the phone plugged into the charger.

An Ott light or similar crafting / desk light helps.

Connecting on Zoom:

You must have the Zoom app on both your computer and phone. Join the meeting by clicking on the link provided to you. On your phone, when asked if you want to join with Internet audio click **NO**. This prevents echoes that occur even if you use the mute in Zoom.

This setup allows the student to see the teacher on the computer screen while enabling the teaching to see their work via the phone video.
